The aim of this course is to enable students to gain an insight into a wide variety of careers, enabling them to choose the right career path and progress to further training or employment

Course Duration:

The Course runs for a total of 27 weeks from September to May each year during school term time. There is a work experience placement each year which enables students to put their learning into practise. Course is run in the Butler Community Centre

Any student who secures a FAS place is entitled to free childcare place under the CETS scheme with participating Crèches.

Payments: If you are in receipt of a Social Welfare payment, you <u>may</u> be entitled to the FAS part time training allowance.
